FIRST MAILING

EVENT: 2009 BMO Skate Canada NL Sectionals; this competition is a Skate Canada sanctioned event.

DATE: November 8th & 9th, 2008

LOCATION: CBS Stadium, Legion Rd, CBS (see map & directions provided)
Ice surface dimensions: 185' x 85'

ENTRY FEE: \$100.00 per single part events (all Preliminary, Pre-Juvenile, Special Olympic, and Juvenile events except for dance), \$150 for events involving two or more parts (dance events, Pre-Novice, Novice, Junior and Senior pairs and singles). **In addition**, a \$7 officials & technology development fee per skater entered is charged. Please forward this amount (along with amounts for photos) to your home club, who will write **one club cheque** and forward to the host club.

Competitors entering more than one event must complete **an entry form for EACH event**.
Entries **will not be accepted** unless a copy of current **Skate Canada Membership Card is attached**.
Please ensure **applications are filled out completely**, incomplete applications may not be accepted.

PHOTO: A photo of the skater must accompany the entry. If possible this photo should be wallet size. The following information should be noted on the back of the photo: Skater's Name, Age, Home Club, & Skating Category. This photo may be digital and submitted in jpeg format to admin@cbsskatingclub.com.

ENTRY DEADLINE: All entries are due **no later than Friday, October 2nd, 2008**.

Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Technical Representative of the competition. No entry shall be accepted within 48 hours of the starting time of the first event of the competition -- Rule 5108 (d). Late entries shall not affect bye status of previously approved byes.

For those skaters who may be trying tests on the test deadline, please have your entry forms in by October 2nd, then category changes can be emailed or faxed in after the tests.

EVENTS TO BE SKATED: As per the 2007-2008 Skate Canada NL Technical Package.

All **eligibilities** as per Skate Canada Rule Book or Skate Canada Newfoundland & Labrador Technical Package.

The CPC Calculations Principals will be used to determine the results of the competition for all events, with the exception of the Preliminary and Special Olympics categories which will use OBO

TEST QUALIFYING DEADLINE: October 1st, 2008.

AGE RESTRICTION: July 1st, 2008 (your skating age for 2008-2009 is the *age you were* on June 30th, 2008)

MUSIC: Two copies of the music are to be submitted to the music committee at registration. Music should begin not longer than 3 seconds beyond the leader tape on cassettes. CDs are also acceptable. Each cassette/CD and case should be clearly marked with the following information:

- 1) Skater's name and home club
- 2) Category
- 3) recording time of music
- 4) "Master" or "Copy".

Pre-Juvenile and Juvenile Dancers will use Series 8 Music.

Pre-Novice and Novice Dancers will use ISU music

COACHES ACCREDITATION: Coaches must be members of Skate Canada; NCCP Level 2 Certified and possess a valid First Aid Certificate. Coaches must register and present their identification at the registration desk.

SCHEDULE: A detailed schedule will be posted at www.skating.nf.ca, as soon as possible after October 24th.

REGISTRATION: Is set to begin at the CBS Stadium, one hour prior to the start of schedule. Registration will also be held at the meet & greet on Friday evening, see MEET & GREET below.

ITEMS SKATERS MUST BRING TO THE ONSITE REGISTRATION:

- Preliminary – music

- Pre-Juvenile - music and completed program content forms

- Juvenile and higher - music, completed program content forms, completed and signed waivers and rules of conduct – these will be available soon

MEET & GREET: There will be a Meet & Greet for everyone held at the Holiday Inn in St.John's on Friday evening, from 7:00pm-9:00pm. Registration will be available during this time.

SKATER PROFILE: All skaters in Pre-Juvenile or higher categories are required to complete their skater profile in the members only area of the Skate Canada NL website. Please ensure it is FULLY completed.

OPENING CEREMONIES: All skaters are expected to participate with the exception of those skaters competing immediately following the ceremonies. All Clubs and Regions are expected to bring their banners. Dress code for the ceremonies includes skating club suits, competition attire, or dress pants, **no jeans please**. Further details will be provided in the next announcement.

MEDAL PRESENTATIONS: All medals and awards will be presented at the awards banquet after the competition.

There will be a meeting of the **Eastern Challenge and Junior Nationals qualifying team** on Sunday after medal presentation and awards banquet. All skaters should bring with them to the competition a cheque to cover the registration fees, and the required information for the Eastern Challenge and Junior Nationals registration forms (complete music information and complete medical information).

AWARDS BANQUET: There will be an awards banquet held on Sunday evening after the competition. More details will follow in the second mailing.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: See the Hotel Information page of this announcement.

All entrants are responsible for booking and paying their own accommodations.

TRANSPORTATION: Skaters are responsible for their own transportation to CBS / St.John's and transportation between accommodations and the arena.

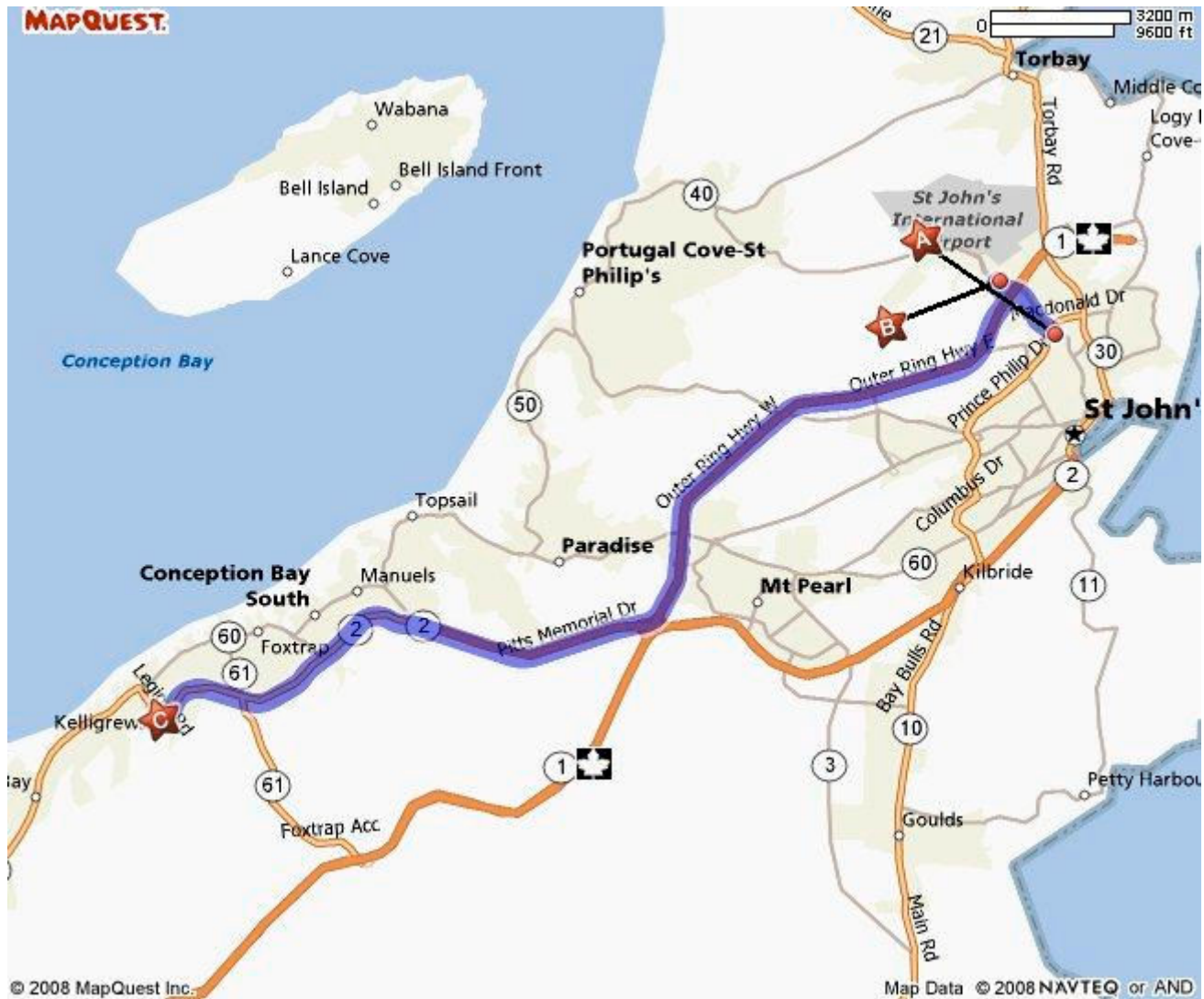

- from the the Holiday Inn



- 1: Head NORTH (turn right from the front entrance parking lot) on Portugal Cove Rd - 1.5km
- 2: Take the T.C.H. WEST ramp. (center lane - turn left)
- 3: Take TRANS CANADA HWY West ; approx. 15 kms (10 mins)
- 4: Take the HWY-2 exit, EXIT 41A - CONCEPTION BAY SOUTH
- 5: Take ROUTE 2 West ; approx. 7 kms (5 mins)
- 6: Take the CONCEPTION BAY SOUTH bypass (left lane)
- 7: Travel to the end of the highway ; approx. 9 kms (7 mins)
- 8: Turn LEFT onto LEGION RD
- 9: The CBS Stadium is on the left hand side of Legion Rd.

Total approximate driving time: 20-25 minutes.
