COACHES ACCREDITATION:

Coaches must be members of Skate Canada in "Good Standing" and NCCP Regional Coach (former Primary STARSkate) Trained or higher. Coaches must register and present proof of coaching status at the registration desk.

SCHEDULE:

A detailed schedule will be posted at www.skating.nf.ca, as soon as possible after the deadline.

ONSITE REGISTRATION:

Will begin one hour prior to the start of first category.

AWARDS:

All skaters will receive an evaluation certificate. Times for Awards Ceremonies will be announced or posted at the Arena.

The STAR Provincial Event is a non-qualifying event to provide skaters in the STAR program an opportunity to gain competitive experience.
