*Dear Parents/Guardians:*

*The Canskate Element Event is an initiative developed by Skate Canada in support of the organization's ongoing implementation of the Long-Term Athlete Development Model. The event has been formatted to introduce participants to the "competition" component of sport while providing them with the opportunity to showcase their skills in a fun and interactive environment.*

*The focus of the event is on individual skill improvement and therefore performances are not ranked. Instead of the traditional podium presentations of placing first, second and third, all skaters receive a certificate indicating their overall performance levels (gold, silver, bronze, merit). The award levels are based on execution of four individual elements performed in a circuit format. Each element is evaluated using three predetermined performance features. Each skater receives a full overview of his/her performance on a "performance standards chart" which is provided to the skater along with the award certificate.*

*Each group is on the ice for approximately 20 minutes (including warm-up, practice time, 2 assessment circuits and group bow). Skaters must arrive no later than 30 minutes prior to their scheduled time and awards are presented approximately 30 minutes following the completion of each event group*
